

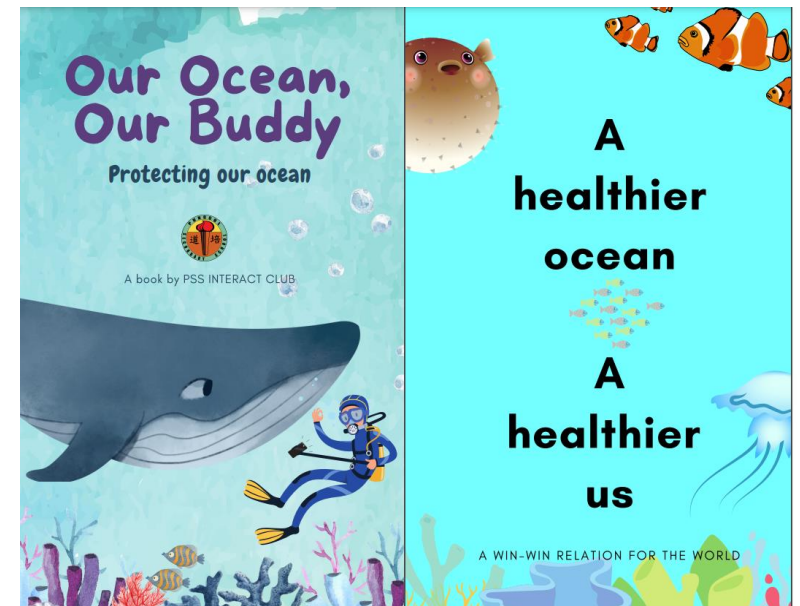
INTERACT CLUB
