Selection Trial Students must fulfill the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Audition Shortlisted candidates are to perform 2 contrasting pieces (with live or recorded accompaniment) ▪ Interview
Community and Youth Leadership	<p>1. Students must fulfill the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ have a keen interest and passion in leading their peers in service to the community; ▪ exhibit positive attitude and commitment towards learning and community service; ▪ attain a Conduct Grade of at least 'Very Good' in Primary 5 (overall) and Primary 6 (mid-year); and ▪ Assumed leadership role in primary school e.g School prefects, Class Chairperson, CCA Captains or CCA Presidents. <p>2. Experiences in the following areas would be a bonus:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Local and/or overseas service learning ▪ Community outreach and VIA projects <p>3. All DSA applicants will be required to provide documentary evidence of their conduct and participation in community service. Interviews will be conducted where necessary.</p>
Environmental Science	<p>Students must fulfill the following criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Have a strong interest in subjects such as Science and Mathematics ▪ display a keen interest in environmental issues and actively engages in activities that are aimed at preserving the environment and promoting environmental awareness ▪ hold leadership positions in primary school (example, Environmental Ambassador/ Environment Club Chairman/Vice Chairman, etc); or ▪ have done well in Science / Mathematics / Design-related / Environmental-related competitions or projects at school or national level <p>All DSA applicants will be required to provide documentary evidence of the above criteria. Interviews will be conducted where necessary.</p>

Shortlisted applicants will be required to attend a selection trial / interview between 1st July 2019 and 30 August 2019.
